COACHING BIO

Cricket has always played a big part in my life – from my first game of garden cricket at age 3 (ish) through to becoming an employee of Wiltshire Cricket straight after University. I learnt to play the game as a seam bowler, but after deciding that my height complimented spin bowling more, I quickly converted to leg-spin and a few years later, when my club's 3rd XI team was missing a wicket-keeper one week, I was asked to sub-in, and it turns out, I was much better at this than flighty leg-spin, so I'm now fortunate to represent Hatherley & Reddings CC 1st XI in WEPL Prem 2 each week, as a wicket-keeper batsman.



Cricket coaching has been a much smoother journey however, having completed my Level 1 at age 16, Level 2 whilst at Exeter University, and most recently, my Level 3. Through my role at Wiltshire and my many volunteering roles at my club, I've had the opportunity to coach all ages and experiences from All Stars Cricket, through to younger boys/girls club teams (U11, U13 & U15) and of course, the best teams in Wiltshire (U15s Girls, U18s Girls & Women's 1st XI).

Over the last few years, I've been so impressed with the teams and how the County programmes have grown, developed and improved. This is a real credit to all of the players and colleagues that have been involved in the pathway. The Wiltshire teams are always a pleasure to work with and I'm excited to see Wiltshire continuing to improve! We have a great future ahead of us! The 2024 season is also hugely exciting with the introduction of our 1-2-2 sessions, Strength & Conditioning Programme, Sri Lanka Tour and some exciting (Provisional) changes to the summer competitions.

Finally, through our Wiltshire partnership with Western Storm, I'm also fortunate to be one of the coaches on the Emerging Player Programme & Academy Programmes at the Bristol Hub, which has been a great experience so far!

FAVOURITE CRICKET MEMORY?

Too many to mention, but some topical memories include:

- Being 1 of only 2 people, in the world (as far as we're aware) to have climbed Sigiriya Rock (nr Dambulla), dressed in full batting equipment and played cricket on top of the fortress, having raised over £1000 for charity as part of my Hatherley & Reddings Tour in 2018.
- Scoring a 50 in Colombo in 2018 and then having hundreds of photos taken with local players/spectators post-game. A 'celebrity' moment.
- Scoring the winning runs in an U19 T20 game, with a best friend of mine at the other end, to win a local-derby and progress to a final, having been a long way behind in the game, and winning with 1 ball to spare.

HOPES FOR THE TOUR?

The Sri Lanka tour is one of my highlights to the county programme and offers a great opportunity for us to continue to explore and apply our skills, show some 'flare' and most importantly, enjoy the once-in-a-lifetime experience! As a team, the Sri Lanka tour will give us the chance to apply some of our learnings from the 2023 season, in the form of 'batting against spin', 'game-changing fielding', 'bowling options' and our proactive, attacking and exciting approach to the game. As with our fixtures in England, the coaches will be fully supportive of players exploring run-scoring and wicket-taking options (regardless of outcomes), trying to implement some of our practiced skills and playing the game without fear. The tour is a brilliant opportunity for us to approach each game in the style that we've been working towards and as we lead into the 2024 season, if we can take away some confidence, clear game plans, problem-solving tactics and the continued enjoyment of the game, then the tour has been a great success!!



We also hope that everyone takes the time to enjoy the culture, sights and atmosphere in Sri Lanka – it's an amazing country, with incredibly friendly people, so definitely make the most of this part of the tour too! We have a great opportunity to experience this as part of the charity day too, where we can support, help and inspire local schools! (I also hope to eat plenty of the amazing Sri Lankan food and on occasions, try to speak Sinhala to some locals!)
